BYLAW NO. 8371, 2023

A Bylaw to authorize the expenditure of moneys from the
Development Cost Charge Reserve Funds
for 2022 debt retirement related to DCC capital expenditures and for
2022 capital expenditures related to drainage infrastructure, sanitary
sewer infrastructure, and transportation infrastructure DCC capital
projects

WHEREAS the Council has established development cost charge reserve funds for Queensborough drainage, sanitary sewer and parkland development and Mainland transportation and parkland development and;

WHEREAS the expenditure of funds from the reserve funds for the projects identified in this bylaw are anticipated in the City's current financial plan;

THE COUNCIL of the Corporation of the City of New Westminster, in open meeting assembled, ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. This bylaw may be cited for all purposes as the "DEVELOPMENT COST CHARGE RESERVE FUNDS EXPENDITURE BYLAW NO. 8371, 2023".
- 2. The Council ratifies, confirms and authorizes the expenditures up to the amount included in Schedule A from the Development Cost Charge Reserve Funds set out therein.
