PURPOSE

The purpose of this report is to provide Council with the signed Good Neighbour Agreement and the Community Advisory Committee Terms of Reference which incorporate changes requested by Council at the June 26th, 2023 meeting.

BACKGROUND

In response to the feedback received during the consultation process, including suggested mechanisms to address neighborhood concerns, staff has worked with the applicant who has agreed to a Good Neighbour Agreement and a Community Advisory Committee.

At the June 26, 2023 meeting, Council requested changes to the wording in the Good Neighbour Agreement and the Community Advisory Committee Terms of Reference. The revised Good Neighbour Agreement and Community Advisory Committee Terms of Reference which incorporate Council's requested changes can be found in Attachments 1 and 2. The Good Neighbor Agreement has been signed by the applicant and the City's Chief Administrative Officer.

The zoning amendment bylaw for 422 Sixth Street was presented to Council for consideration of adoption at the special Council meeting on June 30th, 2023.
