Subject: 2024 USER FEES & RATES REVIEW

Fees and Rates that are administered by the Engineering Department include the following:

- Animal Control
- Cemetery Services
- Commercial Towing
- Solid Waste
- Highway Use for Utility
- Sewerage System User
- Soil Deposit Regulation
- Street and Traffic
- Subdivision and Development Control
- Waterworks
- Water Shortage Response
- Security Deposit for Damage to Municipal Facilities and/or Obstruction of Roads by Builders
- Q to Q Ferry

Our review of fees involved comparison with other municipalities in Metro Vancouver, industry standards and general demand on City resources. The following is an explanation of the recommended changes to the Engineering Fees and Rates Bylaw 7553, 2013.

Part 1.0 Animal Control Fees and Rates

An estimated rate of inflation as an increase in fees of 3.0% is recommended for New Westminster Animal Services licensing, impoundment and maintenance rates. Animal Services rates are comparable with others in the Lower Mainland. Impoundment and other fees were increased to match other municipalities

An amendment of language to the section 'Removal/Disposal' to 'Cremation/Disposal' and new categories created for clarity as CNW does not offer removal of deceased pet, however, will dispose of, and/or cremate as a for-fee service.

Dangerous Dog has been amended to Dangerous/Vicious dog to accommodate separate definitions in the bylaw, however the fine schedule for both is the same.

Part 4.0 Solid Waste Fees & Rates

Solid Waste Fees and Rates have not been raised in a number of years, while collection and tipping fees have increased throughout the region. As such, minimal increases are recommended to the Solid Waste Fees and Rates portion which align with local municipalities. Cart replacement fees are based on current market values for plastic resins and production costs as well as Staff time for delivery. Basic flat rates will remain for special pickups to cover recycling costs for mattresses and disposal for other large bulky items. City staff can continue to provide subjective pricing for SPU requests of smaller piles of waste materials based upon the \$40 minimum and volume of the load.

The Highway Use Utility Fees and Rates, including Pavement Degradation Fees are proposed to increase by an estimated rate of inflation of 3.0%. These fees apply to a "Canadian Carrier" or "Distribution Undertaking" as defined in the Telecommunications Act (Canada) that wishes to enter on those highways (as defined in the Local Government Act of British Columbia) within the jurisdiction of the Municipality from time-to-time for the purpose of constructing, maintaining, operating and removing fiber optic cables, ducts, conduits, manholes, other accessories, support structures, transmission lines and other related telecommunications facilities.

Part 8.0 Street and Traffic Fees and Rates

Street Occupany Permit Fees and Rates

It is recommended that most Street Occupancy fees and rates be increased by approximately 3.0%, in alignment with an estimated rate of inflation. Rental of revenue-generating parking space is recommended to increase by 50% based on an incremental increase toward a higher average parking occupancy rate (75% vs 60% now, with future increase to 85%). This is consistent with the approach taken by other Lower Mainland municipalities that recover parking meter revenue through Street Occupancy fees. The existing fee for supply and installation of Temporary No Parking signs is recommended to increase by 43% to more closely reflect actual labour and material costs.

More complex construction projects and events require significantly more staff time, including senior staff time, to review and provide responses to applicants. The Ministry of Transportation & Infrastructure (MoTI) publishes a framework that can be used to determine what level of SOP/TMP review will be required. For

2024, it is recommended that the City adopt the MoTI framework for SOP/TMP review, with "Level 2" and "Level 3" projects incurring higher SOP application/TMP review fees. Level 2 and Level 3 projects require review and authentication by a Professional Engineer due to complexity, and therefore require additional time for City staff to review and approve. The fee for this service is also renamed the "Street Occupancy Permit Application and Traffic Management Plan Review Fee" to more closely reflect the service being provided.

The 2024 fee structure also includes a recommendation for higher SOP fees for construction work on major streets (collectors and Major Road Network) and cycling routes/greenways to reflect the higher level of disruption to the public, including transit services and vulnerable road users. This is consistent with the approach taken in several other Lower Mainland municipalities.

To reflect the City's highest priority transportation modes and to keep a lens on disability justice, a new fee is recommended for construction projects that require closure of sidewalks, multi-use pathways, and protected bike lanes. A significantly reduced fee is available for projects that provide accessible alternate facilities for foot traffic and people using various wheeled micro-mobility devices. This approach is consistent with that taken in several other Lower Mainland municipalities and is intended to discourage prolonged or unnecessary impacts to the City's existing sidewalk and cycling network.

A new fee is recommended to recoup staff and material costs for use of Cityowned barricades, including on-site delivery and removal for Parades and Street Festivals. This fee would be levied at the time of issuance of the Temporary No Parking signs.

The "Pre-, post-, and other construction inspection" fee is recommended to be revised to \$62 per inspection to accommodate the City resource compensation component for inspecting public works.

Note 1: The Street Occupancy Permit (SOP) Application and Traffic Management Plan Review Fee only applies to the initial SOP or SOP renewals or extensions that require an amended Traffic Management Plan or other conditions, and only applies to SOPs for the following works:

- -Construction, maintenance and/or ancillary work on street or boulevard -Installation, maintenance and/or removal of utilities on a street or boulevard (excluding City works)
- -Hoarding and/or staging area for private development on a street or boulevard

Level 1 SOPs are issued for projects with minimal impact on the travelling public, typically on low volume and low speed local streets.

Level 2 SOPs are issued for projects with moderate impact on the travelling public, typically involving roads with higher volumes and greater complexity. These permits require review by a Traffic Engineer.

Level 3 SOPs are issued for projects with significant impact on the travelling public, involving roads with higher volumes and speeds, and significant complexity. These permits require review by a Traffic Engineer.

Note 2: Road classifications are as designated in Schedule D of the Street & Traffic By-law. Cycle routes/greenways are as designated in Schedule E of the Street & Traffic By-law.

Street Occupancy Damage Deposits

The City instituted consistent damage deposits for street occupancy in 2022. These fees are collected for Street Occupancy Permits that have reasonable risk of resulting in damage to City street infrastructure (road surface, sidewalk, boulevard) and are only collected on projects that not related to a Building Permit. No changes are proposed for 2024.

Damage Deposits are collected as part of the Street Occupancy Permit process for City infrastructure and the amount subject to any cost incurred by the City will be refunded after the final inspection.

Other Fees

The fees to generate a traffic signal timing report and to process speed hump applications are recommended to increase by an estimated rate of inflation of approximately 3.0%, consistent with many other Engineering fees.

A new administrative fee is proposed for 2024 for public requests of video footage from traffic cameras. In compliance with FOIPPA requirements, the City will be posting signage at locations where video footage is being collected, and it is anticipated that public requests for this video footage will increase as a result. This fee is intended to offset staff costs to respond to these requests, and is consistent with other municipalities that accommodate such requests.

To provide clarification on the purpose of the collection of a damage deposit, title of the Part 12.0 Security Deposit for Damage to Municipal Facilities and/or Obstruction of Roads by Builders has been renaimed to Part 12.0 SDU (Site Development Undertating) – Security Deposit for Damage to Municipal Public Works and/or Obstruction of Roads by Builders.

A new non-refundable inspection fee is proposed, an initial inspection will document the condition of public works bordering a development and serve as a baseline to compare future damages that may occur.

All other fees are recommended to increase by 3.0% in alignment with an estimated rate of inflation.

Security Deposits are required to repair damage to municipal facilities and perform necessary street cleaning, resulting construction work and moving of buildings described under Part 15 of the Building Bylaw.
