Subject: **Heritage Revitalization Agreements in the Queen’s Park Heritage Conservation Area**

PURPOSE

To provide an update to the Community Heritage Commission (CHC) regarding the removal of the temporary suspension of new Heritage Revitalization Agreement (HRA) applications in the Queen’s Park Heritage Conservation Area. This memo is for information.

SUMMARY

At the September 11, 2023 Council meeting, a staff report asked Council for direction on the potential to lift the temporary suspension of new HRA applications in the Queen’s Park Heritage Conservation Area, which had been in place since June 21, 2021. The related staff report to Council is included as Appendix A.

After discussion, Council passed the following resolution:

That Council direct staff to remove the suspension on new Heritage Revitalization Agreement (HRA) applications in the Queen’s Park Heritage Conservation Area and to create a Council priority list for staff to pursue in respect of housing matters.

As a result, new HRA applications for properties in the Queen’s Park Heritage Conservation Area can now be submitted. One new application has been received to date.
