## 1. CALL TO ORDER

Mayor Johnstone called the meeting to order at 1:00 p.m.

Mayor Johnstone recognized with respect that New Westminster is on the unceded and unsurrendered land of the Halkomelem speaking peoples. He acknowledged that colonialism has made invisible their histories and connections to the land. He recognized that, as a City, we are learning and building relationships with the people whose lands we are on.

## 2. MOTION TO MOVE THE MEETING INTO THE CLOSED MEETING

**THAT** Council will now go into a meeting which is closed to the public in accordance with Section 90 of the *Community Charter*, on the basis that the subject matter of all agenda items relate to matters listed under Section 90 and where required, Council does consider that the matters could reasonably be expected to harm the interests of the municipality if they were held in public:

90(1)(d) the security of the property of the municipality;

90(1)(g) litigation or potential litigation affecting the municipality;

90(1)(i) the receipt of advice that is subject to solicitor-client privilege, including communications necessary for that purpose;

90(1)(k) negotiations and related discussions respecting the proposed provision of a municipal service that are at their preliminary stages and that, in the view of the council, could reasonably be expected to harm the interests of the municipality if they were held in public;

90(1)(m) a matter that, under another enactment, is such that the public may be excluded from the meeting;

90(1)(n) the consideration of whether a council meeting should be closed under a provision of this subsection or subsection (2); and

90(2)(d) a matter that, under another enactment, is such that the public must be excluded from the meeting.
