File: Traffic Control Permit

To Whom It May Concern

Please be advised that Metro Vancouver Regional District has been granted a permit and Noise Exception by the City of New West to conduct manhole repairs on WB Stewardson Way between 5th Ave and 20th St. This impact is required to take place at night to provide a safe working space while crews remove and replace a manhole lid and the surrounding concrete.

The work will take place over the course of one evening, between from 10pm to 4am. During this time, WB Stewardson Way will be closed, with a detour in place for WB traffic. Local access will be maintained for 5th Ave, with the road closure of Stewardson immediately north of 5th Ave. All other Westbound traffic will be detoured onto 12th St, then 8th Ave, then 20th St. We apologize for the inconvenience; there are very few options with this detour.

The equipment utilized for this work will be crew trucks, backhoe, concrete saw, dump trucks, concrete drills, hammers, shovels, concrete tools, and a drum roller. The crew will begin by cutting along the edge of the pavement patch with concrete saw (if needed), backhoe will lift and remove old pavement and place in dump truck. Crew will break loose damaged manhole casting and prep area for new manhole casting. Concrete will be mixed and risers placed to set manhole height with the road surface. The manhole casting will be anchored with concrete anchors using a concrete drill, hammer and impact drill. Paving crew will prep surface for asphalt and roll/compact to a finished surface.

To mitigate the noise, engines will be turned off when not in use, and crews will endeavor to minimize the noise made whenever possible. We thank you for your cooperation, and anticipate a timely project with minimal delays.
