Subject: 2025 Budget Public Survey Responses

#### **RECOMMENDATION**

**THAT** the 2025 Budget Survey responses from Residents and Businesses, as presented in Appendix A and B to the staff report titled "2025 Budget Public Survey Responses" dated October 28, 2024 from the Chief Financial Officer, be received for information.

## **PURPOSE**

The purpose of this budget survey is to gather feedback and input from city residents and business owners/operators to better understand financial priorities, challenges, and preferences. The results will help guide budget allocation decisions and ensure that resources are distributed effectively to meet the needs of the community while promoting transparency and fiscal responsibility.

## **BACKGROUND**

An important component in the development of an annual budget is input from residents and businesses. Council provided direction to staff at the July 8, 2024 Council meeting to proceed with the budget survey utilizing the services of Ipsos to gather the responses.

#### **DISCUSSION**

The recommended approach to gather input was to directly mail the survey to a random sample of 10,000 New Westminster residential addresses and all available business addresses in the City, estimated to be 1,735. For those residents who were not part of

the random selection, the survey was made available on the City's website and Finance staff promoted the survey in various City facilities. The following table identifies the dates, times and location that Finance staff promoted the survey:

The total responses received were as follows:

Business	1,735	28	1.6%

Ipsos will be attending the Council meeting to present the results of the survey.

#### FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS

Council approved a \$35,000 service enhancement in the 2024 budget with the actual cost being \$47,500. Staff have offset the additional cost through savings in other areas.

## **OPTIONS**

Options for Council's consideration include:

- THAT the 2025 Budget Survey responses from Residents and Businesses, as presented in Appendix A and B to the staff report titled "2025 Budget Public Survey Responses" dated October 28, 2024 from the Chief Financial Officer, be received for information.; or
- 2. THAT Council provide staff with alternate direction.

Option #1 is recommended.
