## BYLAW NO. 8498, 2025

### A Bylaw to Amend Mobile Food Vending Licence Bylaw No. 7850, 2016

The Council of The Corporation of the City of New Westminster in open meeting assembled ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

#### **Citation**

1. This Bylaw may be cited for all purposes as "Mobile Food Vending Licence Bylaw No. 7850, 2016, Amendment Bylaw No. 8498, 2025."

#### **Amendments**

2. Mobile Food Vending Licence Bylaw No. 7850, 2016 is amended by:
  - a. Replacing section 17 with the following "No person shall carry on Mobile Food Vending on public property other than in a location specified in Schedule "A", which locations are available daily on a first come, first served basis, except as per section 16 or as specified in Schedule "A".
  - b. Deleting section 17A.
  - c. Replacing section 20(b) with the following "ensure that any generator used to provide power to the Food Truck does not create a nuisance to residents and other business operators in vicinity, with the exception of Temsewtxw Aquatic and Community Centre where no generators are permitted."
  - d. Replacing section 20(l) with the following "only operate Mobile Food Vending on designated public property during the following hours:
    - (i) park locations: during park opening hours;
    - (ii) other public property locations: between 6:00 a.m. and 1:00 a.m. the following day;"
  - e. Replacing Schedule "A" with the Schedule "A" attached to and forming part of this bylaw as Attachment A.

Schedule "A" to Bylaw No. 7850, 2016

**Permitted Public Locations**

1. Downtown (Columbia Street, Front Street and Carnarvon Street)
  - Carnarvon Street, between Sixth Street and Tenth Street
  - Columbia Street, between Elliot Street and the junction at Stewardson Way
  - Front Street, between Begbie Street and Fourth Street
2. Queensborough (Ewen Avenue)
  - the south side of Ewen Avenue, between Jardine Street and Hampton Street
3. Sapperton (E. Columbia Street)
  - East Columbia Street, between Sherbrooke Street and Braid Street
4. Upper Twelfth Street
  - Twelfth Street, between Tenth Avenue and Sixth Avenue
5. Uptown (Sixth Avenue and Sixth Street)
  - Sixth Street, between Seventh Avenue and Princess Street, and Belmont Street and Fourth Avenue
  - Belmont Street, between Sixth Street and Seventh Street
6. 1319 Third Avenue (outside of Steel and Oak Brewing Company)
  - one parking space located outside of 1319 Third Avenue
7. City Parks & Facilities
  - Tipperary Park, parking lot
  - Moody Park on Tenth Street, one parking space located adjacent the south side of the crosswalk at Hamilton Street
  - Upper Hume Park, one parking spot at the corner of Kelly Street and Hume Lane, in front of the washrooms
  - Ryall Park on Salter Street, one parking space by the picnic shelter between Carter Street and Viscount Place
  - Təməsewtx<sup>w</sup> Aquatic and Community Centre (TACC), one parking spot in the loading zone at the front of the building
    - This location shall only be available at the discretion of the Director of Parks and Recreation
    - No generators permitted, cable ramps required for electrical plug in
    - Booking reservation required
    - Pay the Electricity Supply fee, as identified in Parks & Recreation Fees Bylaw No. 6673, 2001 for each day of vending
