Subject: Development Cost Charges Expenditure Bylaw No. 8513, 2025

RECOMMENDATION

THAT Development Cost Charge Reserve (DCC) Funds Expenditure Bylaw No. 8513, 2025 (Attachment 1) to authorize a total expenditure of \$1.53M from the DCC Reserves be introduced and given first, second, and third readings.

<u>PURPOSE</u>

The purpose of this report is to obtain Council's approval of DCC Reserve Funds Expenditure Bylaw No. 8513, 2025 authorizing expenditures from the City's DCC Reserves.

<u>ANALYSIS</u>

The following table identifies the 2024 capital projects and debt repayments to be funded from the DCC reserves. The expenditures have been included in the City's 2024 – 2028 Five-Year Financial Plan.

OPTIONS

There are two options for Council's consideration; they are:

Option 1 – That Development Cost Charge Reserve Funds Expenditure Bylaw No. 8513, 2025 (Attachment 1) to authorize a total expenditure of \$1.53M from the Development Cost Charge Reserves, be introduced and give first, second, and third readings.

Option 2 – That Council provide staff with alternative direction.

Staff recommend option 1.

CONCLUSION

The City incurred \$1.53M in expenditure on a number of DCC projects provided for in the 2024 – 2028 Five-Year Financial Plan. In accordance with legislation, a bylaw is required to expend funds from DCC reserves.
