WHEREAS May 14, 2025, marks Childhood Apraxia of Speech Day during which

awareness will be raised throughout New Westminster BC, Canada, about Childhood Apraxia of Speech, an extremely challenging

neurological speech disorder that affects 1-in-1,000 children.

WHEREAS Childhood Apraxia of Speech (CAS) causes children to have significant

difficulty learning to speak and is among the most severe speech

disorders in children.

WHEREAS the act of learning to speak comes effortlessly to most children, those

with Apraxia require early, appropriate, and intensive speech therapy.

WHEREAS without appropriate speech therapy intervention, children with Apraxia will

have diminished communication skills, but are also placed at high risk for

secondary impacts including socially and on their futures.

WHEREAS public awareness about Childhood Apraxia of Speech in Vancouver, BC,

Canada, is essential for families of children with this neurological disorder and the professionals who support them to achieve the needed services

for those learning to use their own voice.

WHEREAS our highest respect goes to these children and their families, for their
