Summary of Agency Consultation

The City undertook early and ongoing consultation relating to the Official Community Plan (OCP) update with a number of government agencies and First Nations. First Nations and agencies received a letter in January 2025 informing them of the various projects underway, and city staff met with First Nation staff and agency staff who expressed interest in learning more about the work. The feedback received was presented at the October 27, 2025 Council Workshop in Attachment 9 ([which can be found here](#)) and was focused on the implementation of Provincial housing legislation and Housing Accelerator Funds.

A summary of the feedback received that directly relates to the subject of this report has been provided below.

Metro Vancouver Regional District

- Metro Vancouver expressed a desire to standardize land use designations across municipalities, but recognizes that due to the constraints of the OCP update this is not possible at this time.
- Metro Vancouver was pleased to know that the City is working to strengthen tenant protections by updating the Tenant Relocation Policy.
- Staff shared a draft of the Regional Context Statement with Metro Vancouver for their review. Metro Vancouver was generally supportive of the draft. City staff have made minor edits based on Metro Vancouver's feedback.

TransLink

- City staff had a meeting regarding regional planning with TransLink and Metro Vancouver staff, which resulted in TransLink providing a letter of support for proposed changes to the Frequent Transit Development Areas overlay in the Regional Growth Strategy. The letter of support received from TransLink is included in Attachment 10.
